Description

Front: Kopf des Hadrian nach r., mit Lorbeerkranz, rechts i. F. eine liegende Mondsichel; im Perlkreis.

Rear: Aufgeringelte Agathodaimonschlange mit Kopf nachh r.; in den Körperwindungen stecken links ein Botenstab (kerykeion), rechts ein Ährenhalm; im Perlkreis.

Chop mark: A mark of undefined form made normally with a chisel-like tool, for example to test the purity of the core of a coin. It can also be the result of damage caused when the object was found.
