## Description

Front: Im Feld drei Lilien. Mit Gegenstempel der Stadt Herford: Balkenschild im Rund.

Rear: Langes, die Umschrift teilendes Kreuz, in den Winkeln F-R-A-C.

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
