Description

Front: Kopf des Galba mit Lorbeerkranz nach r.

Rear: Victoria steht auf einem Globus nach l. Sie hält in ihrer vorgestreckten r. Hand einen Kranz und in ihrem l. Arm einen Palmzweig.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
